## Bugs Fixed

### *Main Screen – Preferences*

- › On the Updates tab, from the Preferences menu, the feature “Ensure that all users are on the latest version” was not working properly.

### *Configuration – Company – Suppliers*

- › Whenever a Supplier was deleted an error message was shown.

### *Configuration – Company - Organization*

- › Whenever a function was deleted an error message was shown.

### *Configuration – Costs - Accounts*

- › Whenever an Account was deleted an error message was shown.

### *Plant – Maintenance Plans*

- › On the Work Descriptions tab from the Maintenance Schedules, whenever you selected a column from the work descriptions list, the execution sequence changing operations (Upwards / Downwards) wouldn't work properly.

### *Work Orders Module – Work Orders*

- › In some situations, when an Item Down Time was recorded, when concluding a Work Order, the Item was being set in Down State incorrectly;
- › Whenever a Systematic Work Order was concluded, and the next Maintenance Schedule from the maintenance cycle was associated with a Work Description from the Standard Work Description Library, tasks description, in some cases, appeared in duplicate, on the Tasks tab and on the Work Description;
- › Whenever a Systematic Work Order was concluded, and the selected Item was a MME, the information regarding the Calibration Status was not being automatically recorded.
- › On the Work Descriptions tab, whenever you selected a column from the work descriptions list, the execution sequence changing operations (Upwards / Downwards) wouldn't work properly;
- › Whenever you opened a Reading in the work order, the date and time of the record would change to the operating system current date and time;
- › Whenever you terminated a systematic work order, with no work descriptions associated to it, the next work order would have no planned tasks;

- › In some situations, the message “Access denied. Please contact the system administrator.” would show up, even if the user had all accesses regarding work order operations.

#### *Materials – Master Articles*

- › Whenever a Stock Item was deleted an error message was shown.

#### *Costs – Maintenance Budgets*

- › When working with a Microsoft Access database, whenever you selected an Account on a Maintenance Budget and error message was shown.
